- 1 Collapse of a cliff or hill (9)
- 4 This grounded all planes in the UK in April 2010 (3)
- 9 Your council maps areas at risk from this (5)
- 10 These start as tropical storms - until they gain speed (9)
- 12 Slang form tornado (7)
- 15 This hazard only happens where there is a lot of snow (9)
- 16 This is a cloud of hydrochloric acid, produced when lava meets the sea (4)
- 17 These leave large craters in the ground (6,7)
- 19 This can be measured on the Richter scale (10)
- 21 A large round hole in the ground - they often appear without warning (8)
- 23 Long spell of unusually high temperatures (8)

- 2 A sudden discharge of electrostatic energy (9)
- 3 This can be caused by a submarine earthquake (7)
- 5 Associated with cumulo nimbus clouds (12)
